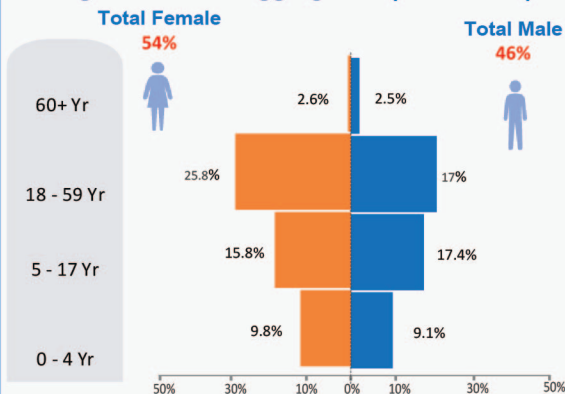

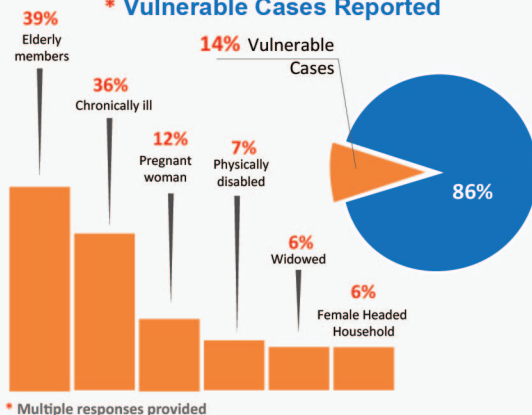

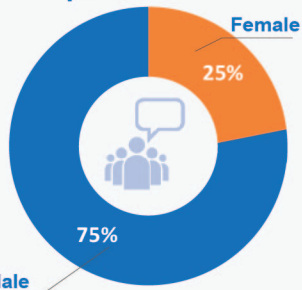
Age-Gender Disaggregation (Individuals)



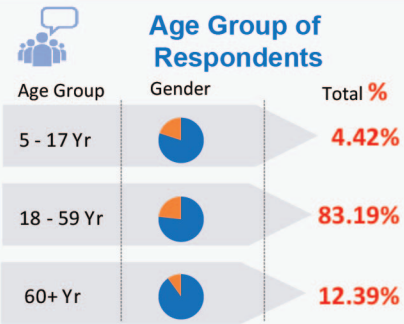

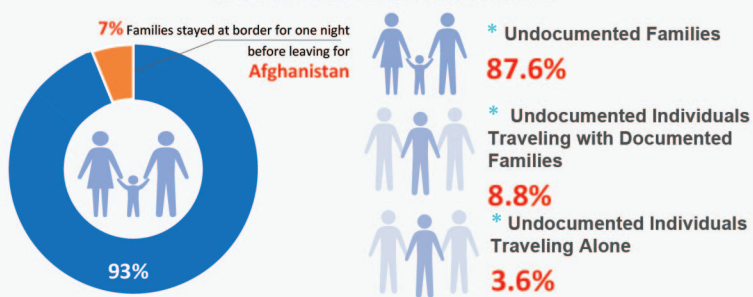
Respondent Gender



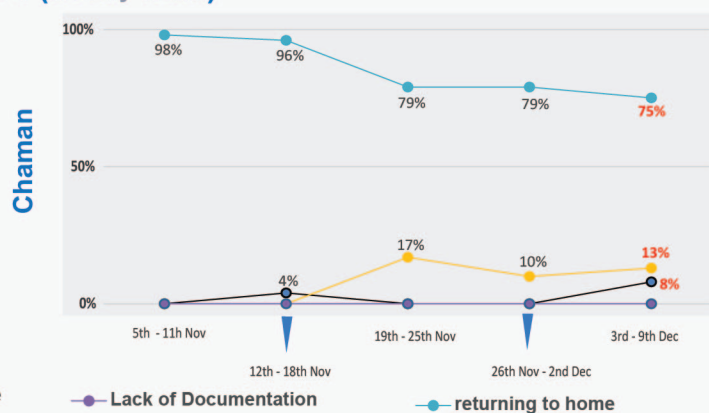
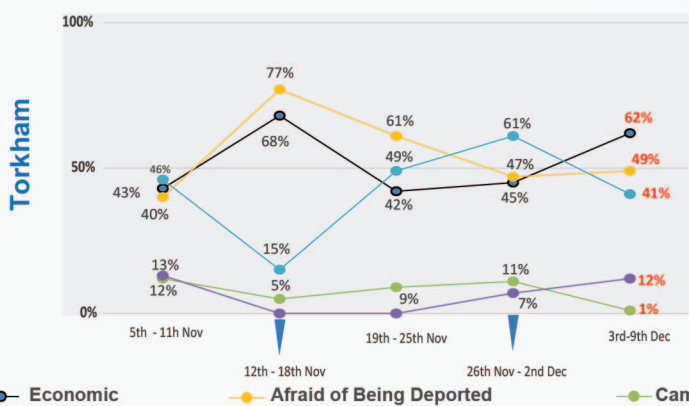

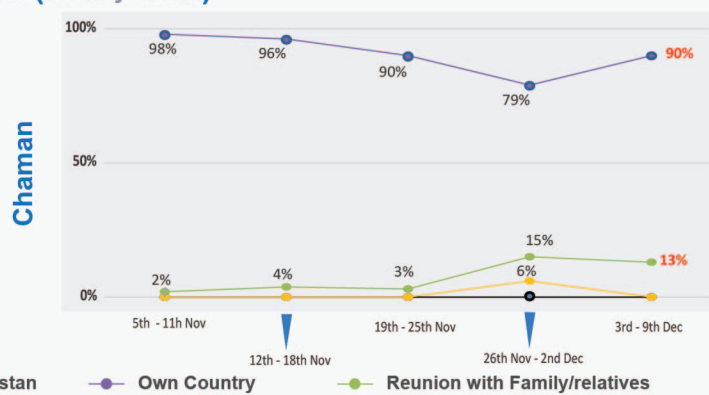
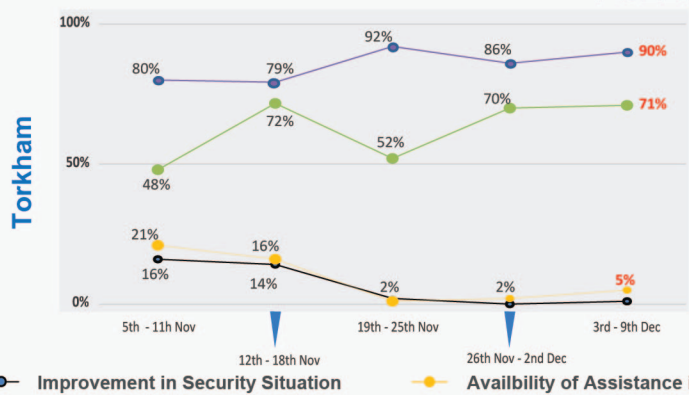

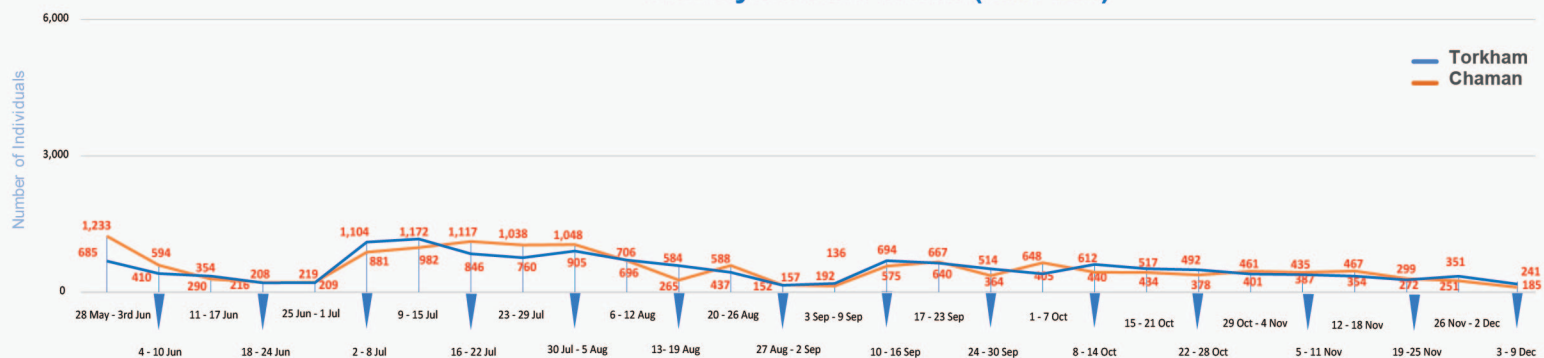
PUSH Factors (Weekly Trend)



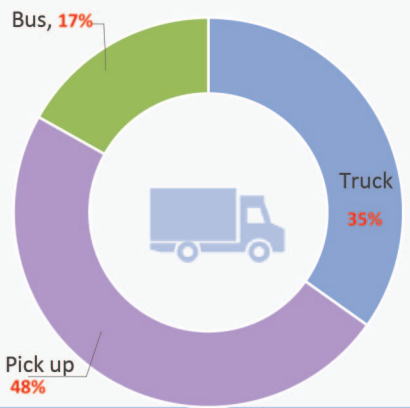
PULL Factors (Weekly Trend)



Weekly Return Trend (Jun - Dec)



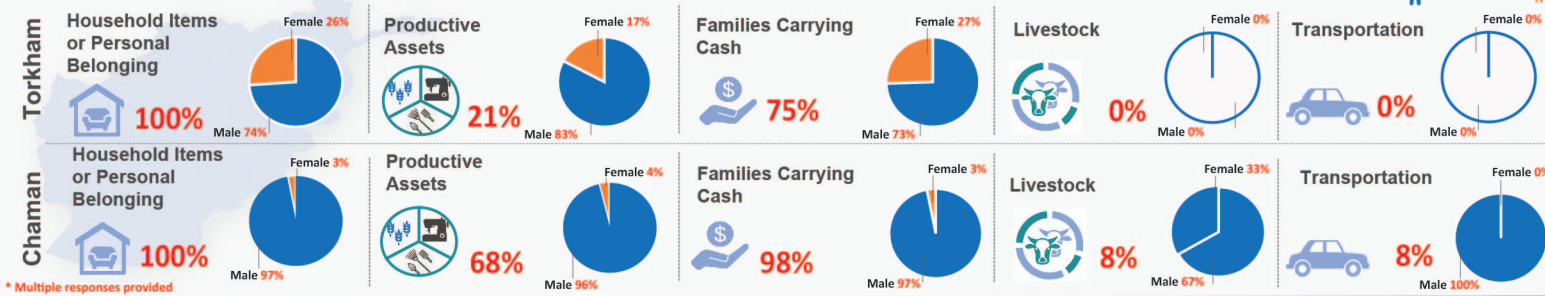

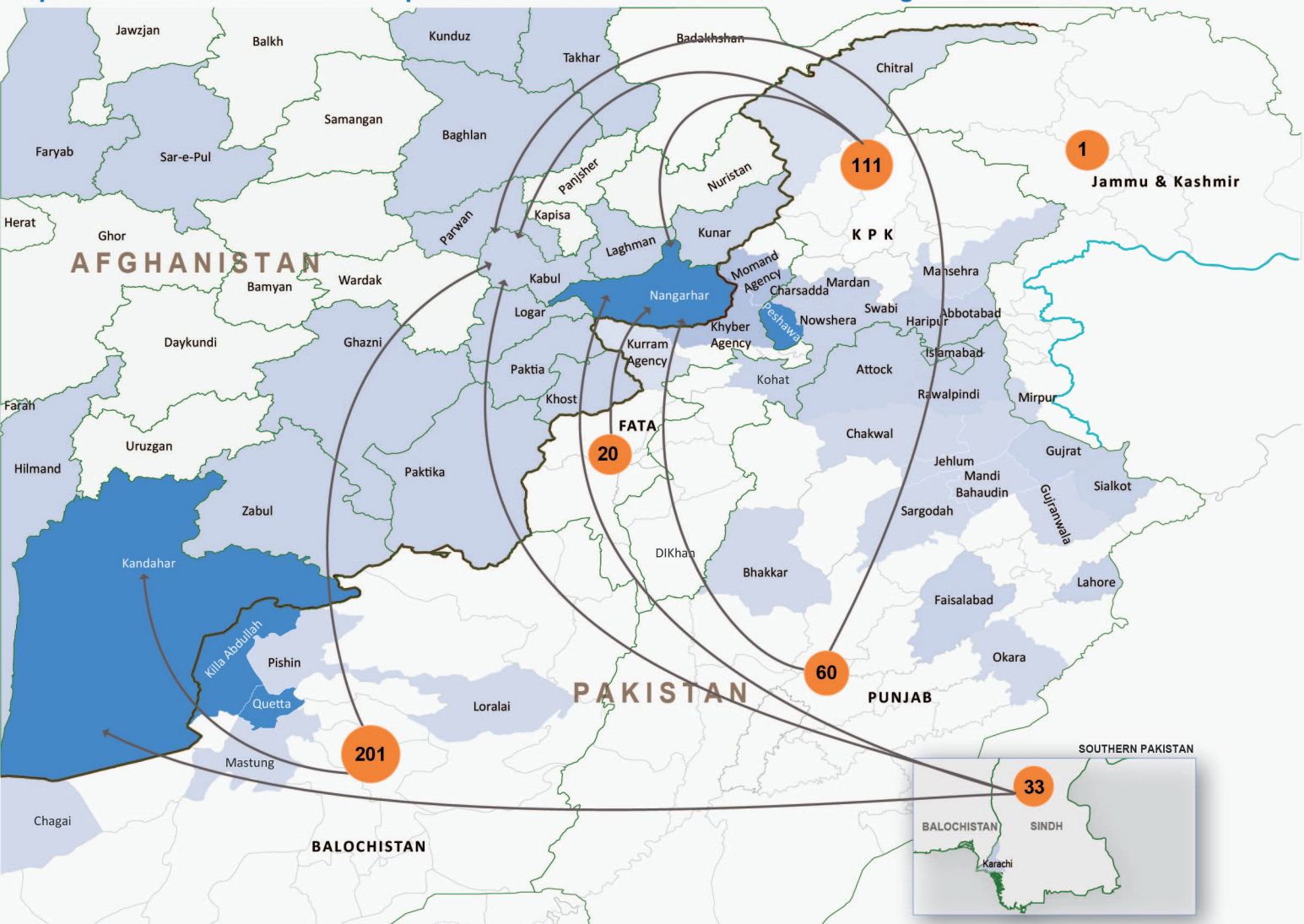
